**Eleanor Wallis writes:** 'As we come to the end of 2024, we reflect on how our **East Sussex Health Complaint Advocates** have been supporting the people of East Sussex. We've been busy - in the last quarter alone we've supported 74 individual cases through the NHS complaints process.

The people we support often have individual outcomes they are hoping to achieve by making a complaint, for example

the advocacy people influencing a change to an NHS service; or receiving answers about a relative's care. We pride ourselves on ensuring local people's voices are heard and wish everyone a safe and restful winter season.'
